## Education & Skills Learner/Apprentice Privacy Policy

The privacy and security of your personal information is very important and we want to ensure that your data does not end up in the wrong hands or being used in any ways it shouldn't. In this document we tell you how we use and look after your personal data and your legal rights.

This policy applies to you if you apply to us and/or start on an apprenticeship or course with us. You may have given us your personal information by phone, in person, on a written form, via the website or social media.

## 1. Who we are

The Growth Company Education & Skills is a training provider. We provide courses, degrees and apprenticeships. We operate through a company called Skills & Work Solutions Limited, which is part of a wider group of companies which come under The Growth Company brand.

2. The data we collect about you

Personal data or information means any information about an individual from which that person could be identified. We may collect, use, store and transfer different kinds of personal data such as:

- Identity name, date of birth, gender
- Contact home address, email, telephone numbers, parent contact details
- Financial bank details
- Transaction details about payments to you
- Application employment history, passport or other ID
- Technical IP address, browser type and version and other data about how you've accessed our website
- Profile interests, career goals, survey responses
- Usage how you use our website, how you are progressing on your apprenticeship or course
- Marketing whether or not you want to receive marketing messages from us
- Special ethnicity, learner support needs, criminal convictions

If you fail to provide the data we request we may not be able to progress your application or take you on as a learner.

3. How is your data collected

You may give us your data when you visit our website/social media pages, fill in forms or contact us such as when you make an enquiry, apply for or start on an apprenticeship or course with us. We may also receive personal data about you from other places and people:

- Job boards e.g. Get my First Job, Career Map, RADAMA (identity, contact, profile data)
- Your school or careers advisor or someone else who is helping you apply for courses and apprenticeships (identity, contact, profile data)
- Analytics providers such as Google (technical data)
- 4. How we use your data

We will only use your personal data when we are allowed to by law. The most common reasons why we use your data is to

- Where we need to form a contract with you
- When it is necessary to use the data in order to provide the services we offer, providing we balance your rights when we do this (known as 'legitimate interests')
- Where we need to because it is a legal requirement

• Criminal convictions – you may choose to tell us about any previous criminal convictions when we interview you or whilst you are learning with us (consent)

## Marketing

You will only receive marketing communications from us if you have told us you want to. You can ask us to stop sending you marketing messages at any time by following the opt-out links on any marketing message.

5. Sharing your personal data

We may have to share your personal data with some organisations for the purposes in the table above:

- Your school and/or careers advisor
- Potential employers
- ESFA

They are only allowed to process your personal data in the ways we tell them or which they are legally required to do. For schools and careers advisors, this is so they know what course or apprenticeship you're going to do with us. For employers, this is so they can see if you would be suitable for an apprenticeship with them. For the ESFA, this is so they can pay us for the training we are providing.

6. Data security

We have security in place to stop your data being lost or used in an unauthorised way. If we do suspect that something unauthorised has happened to your data we will let you know.

7. Data retention

The length of time we keep your data is determined by the government departments which fund

8. Your legal rights

Sometimes you have rights in relation to your personal data and are entitled to:

- Request access to your personal data
- Request correction of your personal data
- Request erasure of your personal data
- Object to processing of your personal data
- Request restriction of processing your personal data
- Request transfer of your personal data
- Right to withdraw consent
