ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION COURSES

SFE will write off the outstanding balance for your Access to HE Diploma loan once you complete your degree.

Entry Requirements

You must have the highest vocational qualification relevant to that subject area. For some subject areas this means a National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) Level 3, and for others it may be an NVQ Level 4 or a Higher National Diploma (HND). You must gain an Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) Disclosure certificate for a Child Workforce including Child Barred List Checks, before starting your teaching practice.

FUNDING YOUR COURSE

Chartered Manager Degree Apprenticeship (CMDA)

Overview

This course is for people who are looking to develop into a management role or for managers looking to gain a management qualification and want to develop fully all aspects of their management and leadership skills, knowledge, self-awareness and behaviours. These include strategic decision making, setting direction and achieving results.

Professional managers will be capable of managing complexity and delivering impact at a strategic and/or operational level, with management and leadership responsibility for setting and delivering organisational objectives through a wide range of functions.

Entry Requirements

A Level 3 qualification in any subject. If you do not possess GCSEs in English and Mathematics at grade C or above or grade 4 to 9 - or hold an equivalent such as Functional Skills Level 2 in Literacy and Numeracy - you will be asked to complete initial assessments for English and mathematics. The results of these assessments will determine whether you are accepted on to the apprenticeship with your current qualifications, or a recommendation of delayed entry is made so you can undertake studies enabling you to achieve the required level of English and mathematics prior to commencing the apprenticeship.

Admission to this programme is only available to candidates who meet the following criteria. 1) They are employed for a minimum of 30 hours per week in a role relevant to the apprenticeship. 2) They have the right to live and work in the UK. 3) Their employer is participating in the Degree Apprenticeship scheme. 4) Their employer is willing to sponsor them to attend the University one day per week (times and dates to be determined). Please note that an apprentice cannot be self-employed.

All students on a Higher Education course (excluding CMDA) can apply for a tuition fee loan. These loans are dependent on your income and are available to all part-time and fulltime students. You only need to start paying your loan back once you're earning over £19,390. For example, if your salary is £20,000 per year before tax then your approximate repayment is £4 per month. If your salary drops below £19,390 then your payments will stop. Please note that this is an example only and subject to change.
