

This apprenticeship is for those work in the construction sector, manufacturing fenestration products such as conservatory roofing, curtain walls, glazed doors, glazed screening, roof lanterns, roof lights, patent/slope glazing, secondary glazing, shop fronts and windows.

Fenestration Fabricators may supply directly to homeowners (retail/domestic market), the newbuild market (house builders) or the commercial and public sector (local authorities, offices, shops, schools and hospitals etc). They can also supply the commercial refurbishment market.

Typical job roles include:

- Aluminium/uPVC Fabricator
- Double Glazing Window Factory Fabricator
- Fabricator
- Production Operative
- Windows/Doors Fabricator

The apprenticeship standard covers a wide range of knowledge, skills and behaviours which include:

- Legislation, regulations and industry standards
- Health and safety
- · Techniques for fitting components
- Processes for handover to other functions/customers
- Interim and final checking requirements
- How to stack and store products and materials safely, effectively and securely

Duration:

16 – 18 year old – 26 months 19+ - 24 months

Apprentices without level 1 English and maths will need to achieve this level and apprentices without level 2 English and maths will need to take the tests for this level prior to taking the end-point assessment. For those with an education, health and care plan or a legacy statement, the apprenticeship's English and maths minimum requirement is Entry Level 3.

Apprentices must spend 20% of their contracted hours completing off-the-job training which works out around 1 day per working week.
